

# Propagation is the name of the game!

As mentioned in a previous newsletter one of our main learning intentions this term is understanding propagation. Students have been learning the science behind how to propagate plants as well as the practical implications. We have been learning the difference between propagating monocotyledon plants and dicotyledon plants by examining the difference in plant structure and growth. This week we have been focusing on dicotyledon plants such as Basil, Hibiscus, Mussaenda and Garden Balsam. These are just a few of the plants we are propagating in readiness for our plant sale. The YR5/6's have shown that they are independent, curious learners and are able to process information and apply their new knowledge to practical situations. 
