Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Northern Territory Government has a \$150.00 per child Back To School Payment Scheme. The Back To School Scheme entitlement funds are provided to schools on behalf of parents. Schools provide the goods and services for parents to purchase with their entitlement.

Parents or guardians of NT students enrolled from Preschool to Year 12 in Term 1 are eligible for the Back To School Payment Scheme which must be accessed by the end of Term 1. However, parents or guardians of preschool students enrolled in an NT school can access the entitlement in the term the student first enrols provided their child has not previously enrolled and attended another NT school in 2019. If you have not yet accessed the \$150 NT Government Back To school Payment, please visit the front office.

The School Board has suggested \$150.00 for voluntary parent contributions. Many thanks to those parents who have already made voluntary parent contributions to the school as these funds further assist our school programs and projects.

The wearing of school uniform is compulsory in all government schools. Please ensure that your child wears their uniform to school every day.

Larrakeyah Primary is an Independent Public School (IPS) – one of the first six selected IPS in the Northern Territory and recognised for its commitment to high expectations, high standards and high achievement. I trust 2019 will be a happy and successful year. The partnership between home and school is always important. If you have any concerns or issues regarding your child, we encourage you to contact the class teacher in the first instance. Tutoring Term 1, 2019

The Literacy and Numeracy Tutoring Program

Larrakeyah Primary School offers a Literacy and Numeracy Tutoring Program. This innovative program is designed to enhance classroom learning for students needing further instruction, support, or extension in the areas of Literacy and Numeracy. The Tutoring program will provide students with the opportunity to challenge themselves and develop areas of weakness that may be impeding their progress in Literacy and Numeracy.

This is an afterschool program that will run for 8 weeks of each term. Tutoring sessions fall into two categories: Literacy and Numeracy. One hour sessions will be available for students in the year levels 2—6. Tutoring sessions will be limited to a minimum of 2 students and a maximum of 5 students to ensure each student receives individual support from the tutors. The cost of these sessions is \$320 for 8 weeks.


DCO - Welcome to the Top End! Defence Community Organisation is hosting a community connections expo.

Registration forms can be handed in to the School Office. Please contact the Tutoring Coordinator, Natasha Guse, on 8981 3211 (School Office) or by email (natasha.guse@ntschools.net) should you require further clarification.

Important Notes for Parents

- Enrolment is on a first-in, first-served basis. Confirmation of enrolment will be sent out from Wednesday 6th February, prior to commencement of the Tutoring Program, if registration forms are received by then. Students may enrol during the term if places are available.
- Tutoring sessions will be limited to a minimum of 2 students and a maximum of 5 students to ensure each student receives individual support from the tutors.
- Where possible all students are given their first choice. Once first choice options are full then second options
 are offered. Those students who do not get their first option are a priority for their second option and are also
 waitlisted for their first option in case a spot becomes available.
- Weekly sessions will commence Term 1, Week 3, week beginning Monday 11th February (3pm 4pm) and continue for 8 weeks, finishing on the week beginning Monday 1st April.
- Payment is due upon receipt of statement of account and before commencement of the Tutoring session your child is in to guarantee a place in the program.
- Term programs will be invoiced in full and will be pro-rated if a student commences part way through the term. Refunds will only be offered for a change of mind within the first 4 weeks of the program. An amount of 50% of the remaining session costs will be refunded. This is to cover the cost of the tutor and the fact that another student may have missed a full term place in that program. In this case you may need to contact the Tutoring Coordinator to discuss options for your child.
- · Payment is only required when you have received notification of the offer of a place in a session
- It is a parent's responsibility to organise suitable transport home from school at the completion of the activity.
 Parents must pick up their child at the end of the Tutoring session or make alternative arrangements for your
 child to be collected from outside the school office. If your child attends OSHC the instructor/teacher will
 take them to OSHC. If your child is not being collected by yourself, or another adult, a note must be sent to
 school explaining how your child will be getting home (e.g. walking, catching a bus, riding a bike). In the
 event your child is consistently late being collected (3 times without notification) then they will be asked to
 stop attending the Tutoring Program.
- · If a session is cancelled, a make-up session will be arranged at a later date and parents will be notified.
- Once students have enrolled in the Tutoring Program, their attendance each week is compulsory. During the term, if they are absent from the Program on 3 or more occasions without an explanation they will be deemed as having withdrawn from the activity.
- If a student is absent for a session there will be no refunds or make up sessions unless the absence is due to a school activity.
- If a student's behaviour is deemed unacceptable, or they are interfering with the learning of other students in the tutoring session parents will be informed. If the mis-behaviour continues they will be removed from the program. An amount of 50% of the remaining session costs will be refunded.
