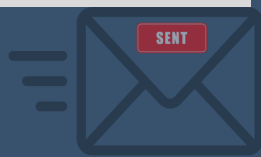

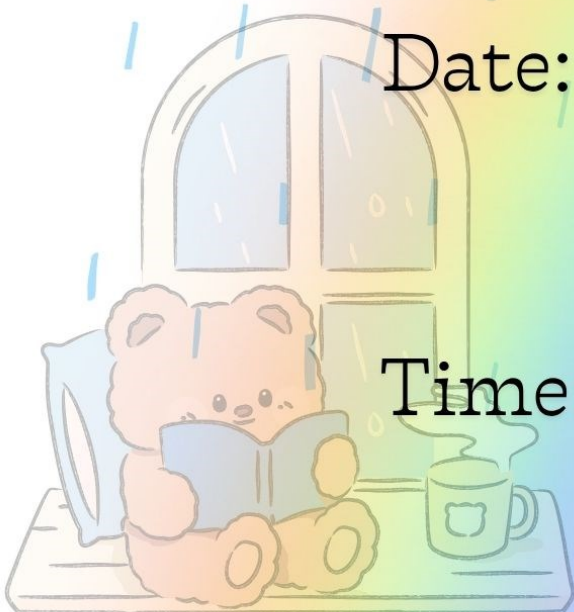

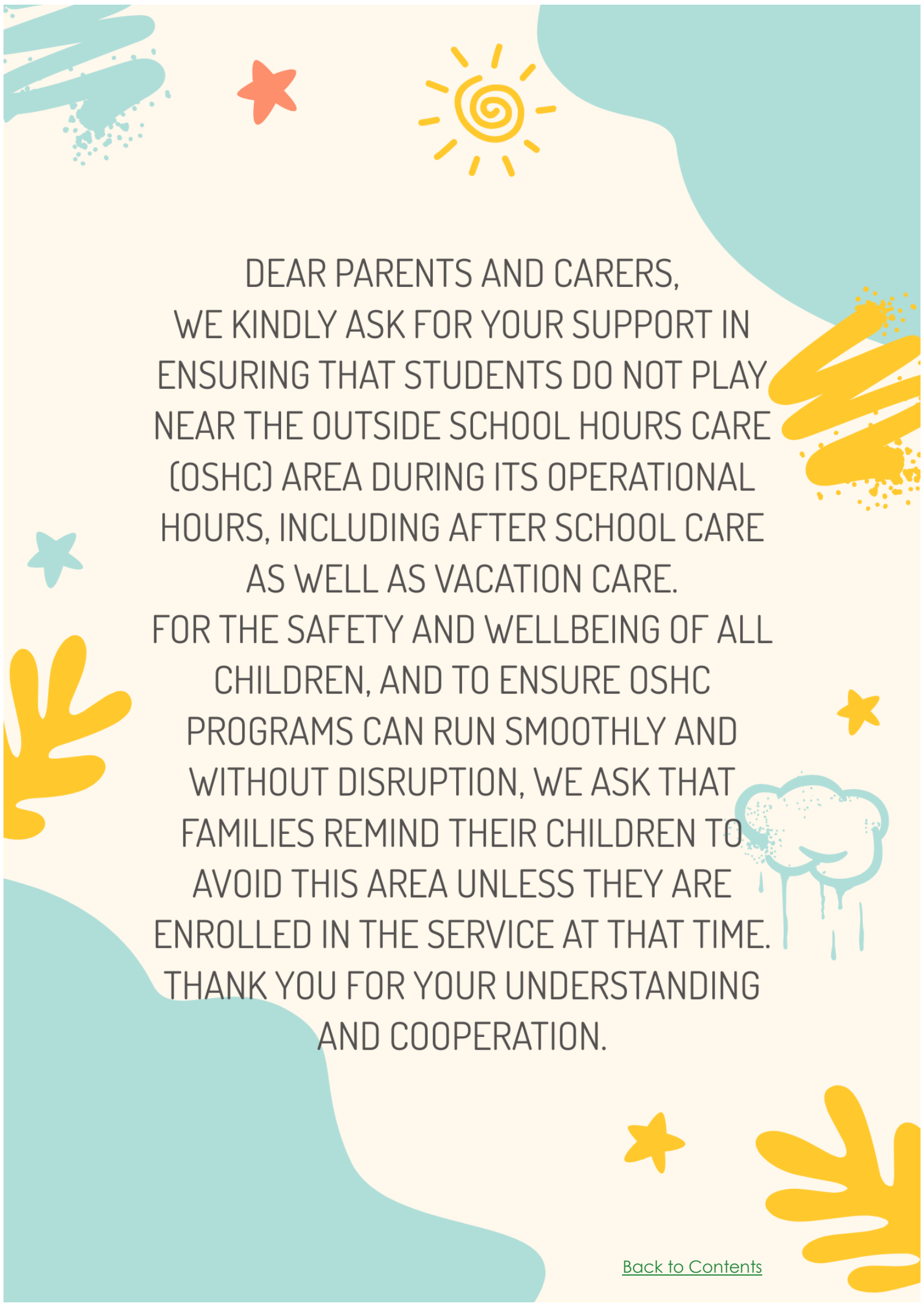
Items and Valuables at School

SCHOOL BUS TRAVEL

Bus 103 can become quite congested in the afternoon with some students unable to get on due to numbers. Bus 209 is an alternative option for some of our students, especially those who live in Bayview.
